The purpose of the pavilion booths is to provide attractive displays that illustrate something related to the Christian life. Opportunity for interaction with guests is very desirable. Three of the booths will be samples of crafts that can be made as gifts. Instructions will be posted on the wall next to the craft tables for guests to easily take pictures with their phone cameras. Plans include having our usual Christmas tree decorated in red, white and blue which following the festival will be taken for display at the Veteran’s Medical Center on Lake Ave. Guests will have an opportunity to write an encouraging note to a veteran for distribution by the chaplain. One display will be designated for the Gideons to share Bibles, a prayer theme booth with literature that encourages prayer, the hand crafted dresses for little girls and shorts for boys will be on display for guests to write a note to attach before sharing them with Little Dresses for Africa and/or local groups going on mission trips. Plans also include two tables of books by Christian authors. A new feature will be several booths related to Christmas customs in a variety of cultures.

- All presented materials must be family appropriate.
- While you are encouraged to talk about your organization, group or individual(s) no recruiting of volunteers, soliciting future/potential customers or soliciting donations is permitted.
- Different Christian denominations are invited to participate and all are invited to attend. No performances or material of a political nature or promoting one denomination above another will be permitted. During this festival we celebrate what we do all agree on such as what a wonderful and merciful God we worship that sent his Son to live on this earth and paid the price for our sins.

- The Christ Child Festival reserves the right to deny a presentation or require the removal of any signs, materials, displays or handouts or request an organization to leave the festival for any or no reason. By signing below you agree that should removal be requested by a Christ Child Festival board official, you will immediately comply without any immediate or future protest, debate or discussion.
